

# ONLINE THEATRE WORKSHOP

## HOW DOES THE WORKSHOP BENEFIT STUDENTS?

An online theatre workshop allows students studying a play-text to keep **engaged** and **entertained** whilst in isolation. From their own home, they can experience the **creative buzz of a rehearsal room** — looking at key scenes from an actor's perspective and learning how to translate the words on the page into **informed, layered performances**.

To support the study of:

- Shakespeare
- The Crucible
- An Inspector Calls
- And more...



### Key areas of focus:

- Understanding plot
- Understanding character journeys
- Exploring creative theatrical choices
- Ensemble work
- Performance approach to the text
- Language analysis

### STAGE ONE:

All participants meet on Zoom for a morning warm up! Groups and scenes are assigned.

### STAGE TWO:

Groups work individually with Joanna to devise their own interpretation of the scene, using knowledge of themes, language and plot to assist them.

### STAGE THREE:

All students re-convene at the end of the day to meet with Joanna and showcase their work. The key scenes are shown in order to further cement the plot and timeline of the play. They can see from each other how characters change throughout the play, how symbolism is re-visited and themes developed.

### Price:

A full day of workshop activity for an entire class of students costs €500 (negotiable, discounts available for multiple days)
